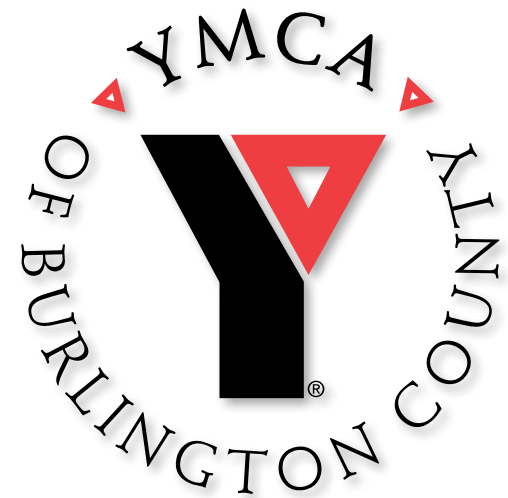

The YMCA of Burlington County recognizes the importance of quality early care and education from birth up to age five. Early childhood programs are the first experience children have with education, and this experience has far reaching positive impacts on the lives of children. These programs impact academic performance, social and physical development, as well as, contributing to the adoption of a healthy lifestyle and avoidance of at risk behavior. With the mission based theory of building strong kids, families and communities the YMCA of the USA and YMCA of Burlington County have the experience and resources of the largest nation wide child care provider. YMCA staff are skilled in caring for and educating children from birth to teens.

High Reach Curriculum

The YMCA Child Care program is part of the High Reach Learning. The HighReach Learning Curriculum Approach is based upon the following principles:

1. A child's development is continuous, individual, and begins at birth.
2. The stages of development are unique to each child.
3. Creating multiple connections supports current brain research for how infants and young children learn.
4. Interactions and relationships are at the heart of learning.
5. Families are truly a child's first teachers and are an integral part of the learning community.
6. Learning experiences are purposeful, interactive, meaningful, relevant, active, and playful.
7. Curriculum is project-focused and is based in play investigation. Play is the avenue for child investigations.
8. The ultimate goal is for children to become ready, able, competent, and eager learners.

We hold our staff to the highest standards. Each lead teacher is required to have a minimum of a Child Development Associates credential. All full time staff must receive 12 credit hours of training per year in order to work in our program and are certified in First Aid & C.P.R.
